

ORDINANCE NO. 1976-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF NEWPORT REGULATING THE KEEPING
AND CONTROL OF CATS

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Newport enacts and ordains:

1. That it shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any cat to fail to Keep at all times such cat either (1) confined within the premises of the owner or keeper; (2) firmly secured by means of a collar and rope or other device so that it can not stray beyond the premises on which it is secured, or (3) under reasonable control of some person.
2. That it shall be unlawful for any person to keep, maintain or house or permit to be kept, maintained or housed in any residential unit more than three cats at any one time.
3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25,00) Dollars and each day's violation shall be a separate offense.
