



## Newport Township

### 2026 Waste & Recycling Collection Information

Anthracite Waste Services provides weekly waste and bulk collection, and Newport Township oversees recycling. Thank you for helping keep our community clean.

#### ONCE-A-WEEK WASTE COLLECTION

Waste is collected either **Thursday** or **Friday** in your area based on the list below. Please have all items at the street the night before to ensure you do not miss your collection.

##### Holiday Schedule:

If a holiday occurs on or before your waste collection day, your pickup will be delayed one day that week.

##### Collection Days

- **Thursday:** Glen Lyon, Lee
- **Friday:** Alden, Sheatown, Wanamie, Ridge View

##### Weekly Limit

Each home is limited to **four (4) 32-gallon cans or bags** each week, not to exceed **33 lbs. per container**. Please bag your waste before placing it in your can.

#### BULK ITEM COLLECTION

Bulk items are collected only during the **first pickup of each month** on your normal waste pickup day. Each home may dispose of **one (1) bulk item per month**.

##### Examples of acceptable bulk items

- Furniture
- Mattress or box spring (must be wrapped in plastic)
- Appliances
- Carpet rolls (bundled, tied, and no longer than 4 ft in length)

**Appliances with refrigerants:** Refrigerators, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers must have the Freon removed by a **Certified Technician**, and a tag must be placed on the unit.

**No items will be collected without a tag.**

#### RECYCLING COLLECTION

Recycling is collected by Newport Township Public Works on **Thursday** or **Friday** based on the list below.

Recycling containers are available at the **Township Municipal Building**

351 Kirmar Ave, Wanamie.

Please see the calendar on the back side for the recycling schedule for newspaper/cardboard and commingled/container recycling.

##### Recycling Calendar Colors

- **Gold Days:** Newspaper and cardboard
- **Green Days:** Commingled containers (plastic, metal)

##### Recycling Collection Days

- **Thursday:** Glen Lyon, Lee, Wanamie
- **Friday:** Alden, Sheatown, Ridge View

##### Set-out guidelines

- Place acceptable recyclables directly into your container **loose** – do not bag recyclables.
- Make sure items are clean and free of food debris and liquids.
- Flatten all cardboard boxes into pieces no larger than about 3 ft.

#### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

**Household hazardous wastes are NOT accepted** in curbside waste or recycling.

Items such as toxic chemicals, pesticides, oil-based paints, automotive batteries, and fuels or fluids must be disposed of properly.

#### ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Due to PA state law, **TVs, computers, laptops, monitors, and other electronics** will **NOT** be collected as waste.
