Newport Township Parks and Recreation Report

August 2026 Commissioner Meeting

Railroad Street Play Area - Progress:

Construction is underway, with visible progress each day. Curbing, park benches, the play station, swings, and soil preparation for grass installation have been completed. To improve site functionality, an additional stormwater collection system will be added to the final scope of work, including a standard inlet to prevent surface stormwater from entering the site. Sod will also be furnished and placed in grass areas as an erosion control measure.

Remaining Work:

- Install the final surface when weather conditions allow.
- Install standard storm water inlet.
- Install exterior fencing as soon as it is available from the vendor.
- Place sod in the designated grass areas.
