

ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 3

AN ORDINANCE OF NEWPORT TOWNSHIP, LUZERNE COUNTY,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING
ORDINANCE NOS. 2018-3

WHEREAS, Newport Township adopted Ordinance No. 2018-3, which adopted the Quality of Life and Violations Ticket Process within Township limits and setting forth penalties for violation thereof;

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to amend Ordinance No. 2018-3;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Commissioners of the Newport Township that;

Section 2. Definitions.

FERAL CATS –A feral cat is a descendant of a domesticated cat that has returned to the wild and/or lives in the outdoors.

Section 3. Quality of Life Violations is hereby amended to include the following:

20. Feral Cats.

a. It shall be unlawful for any person to feed stray or otherwise feral cats or leave out food for stray or otherwise feral cats in Newport Township.


b. Residents have the right to remove feral cats from their property in a humane manner.

c. Any person in violation of this subsection, shall pay a fine in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
