ORDINANCE NO. / OF 1984

An Ordinance prohibiting the shoveling and depositing of snow and/or ice on the public streets and public thoroughfares of Newport Township.

Se it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Newport, County of Luzerne and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, follows:

SECTION 1. Certain Activities Prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any person, individual, firm, cartnership, corporation or other entity to shovel upon and deposit upon the public roads and public thoroughfares of the Township of Newport, County of Luzerne and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, any snow and/or ice.

SECTION 2. Violation and Penalties

Any person, individual, firm, partnership, corporation or other entity who shall be convicted of violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and not wore than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, together with costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fines and costs, the violator shall be subject to imprisonment in the County Prison for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION 3. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or

unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or other parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
