On March 26th 2024 we took delivery of 14 new Scott/3m x3 SCBA as well as 2 Rapid Intervention Team bags made possible by the award of the 2023 Federal Assistance to Firefighters grant. These new SCBA replaced our aging SCBA that were reaching the end of life service. We would like to thank the township in the assistance to obtain these SCBA. They will serve the township for the next 15-20 years.

We also received a new diesel exhaust removal system from Plymovent. The system connects a hose to the exhaust of each apparatus, allowing us to run the apparatus inside of the building.
